### Discussion notes:

- The goal: bringing all people to Christ. Are all these ministries serving that purpose?
- Some ministries need more members/leaders, others are running smoothly
- Put time and energy into the areas that are needing support or lacking
- How are we doing in supporting the vision?
- Opportunity areas identified to support Stewardship + Pastoral Committees moving forward:
  - The current website is difficult to navigate and it's unclear whether the functionality would be possible to
    make it more interactive + supportive of engaging members in ministry. Father invited members of
    Stewardship to put together some thoughts/suggestions on what would be ideal for us to review with
    Carrie.
  - Stewardship/Pastoral committee meetings moving to different dates/times have made it difficult for members to attend. Finding a consistent day + time which allows those who work full time to attend will be a big help for engagement and coordination among the Pillar leaders and committee heads.
  - o Father agreed to include all of the Ministry heads within Stewardship in the quarterly Saturday morning faith-formation meetings he hosts beginning this fall. This is an important time for ministry heads to have their cup filled by Father to be the face of Christ to others in the Parish. There will also be time on these Saturday mornings for the Stewardship committee to break out separately along with being part of the larger group.
