When she and Sue Lang devoted more time, they would personally email and call families to fill the slots. Would love to recruit young families to this ministry. She says the ministry ideal for families with grade-schoolers. How can we help her do this? I suggested that our WATW (Women at the Well) cohort families had kids who were perhaps a little too young, but she has held babies and chased toddlers through it and said they would gladly welcome our families joining. I suggested maybe she could come give a little plug for it at our meeting? (But the next chance for that really won't be until fall!) She has also been meaning to recruit through the school newsletter but has just put off doing so, so I will facilitate that today!

Grief Ministry

Update contact to Linda Conrad, 402-484-6799; MaryLu Cords, the listed leader, did not answer or return my call, and I found Linda's info in the bulletin. She said she recently took over and that MaryLu no longer drives. Their ministry only has about 8 people, mostly in their 80s. Have a bulletin notice requesting more members. They generally attend the Rosary/funeral and give a card to a family of the deceased and then send cards at 3 months and 1 year. They also are in charge of the Remembrance Mass. They need more members. Not sure how we can help with that.

New Member Welcome Dinner (Kristin Streff)

Things going well. Always looking for new homes to host in. Next Welcome Dinner will be on June 17.

Baptism Brunch (Michelle Weber)

We got zero people to join our committee from the Ministry Fair, which was a little disheartening. Right now our ministry is doing all of the work and bearing all of the expense. We would love it if the parish office would mail our invites and/or if there was some financial assistance available for all the food. We are going to only do one of these per year going forward. Next date TBD.

St. Joseph School and School Advisory Report

- SAC has drafted a Jr. High Parent Survey to get parent input on information needed to improve student and family transitions from 6th grade into JH.
 - Survey will be sent to current 6th-8th grade parents to get feedback before the end of the school year
- Nominations for next year's council; terms begin August 2022
 - o Proposed nominees: Kathy Donlan, teacher rep; Nicole Russman, parent rep
 - o Duane Becker will take over as chair beginning in August
 - Nominations for next vice-chair needed
- By-laws state that members must serve a minimum of one year before being able to hold the office of chair or vice chair. Due to the fact that the teachers do not take on these positions and the only qualifying parent reps available for 2022-2023 are Mike Czyz and Chelsea Schauer, we discussed the need to add at least one more parent rep. Mike is unable to fulfill the role of vice chair next year due to work and family obligations, so Chelsea will serve as vice chair for one year. We decided that further nominations will be made in May and confirmed in August 2022.
