Action Items Completed:

• Missing kneelers from original installation have been installed. However, they missed the confessional and usher kneelers. These will be fabricated and installed asap.

Action Items In-progress/Pending:

- Replacement of roof areas J, K, L, M, N (south and east side of Church) has been delayed to November due to delays in receiving roof membrane from manufacturer.
- Evaluating options and costs for the following items:
- Replacement of roof top HVAC unit which serves a portion of the school
- Repairs to Rectory parking lot curbs, sidewalks, and driveway
- School water heater
- Repairs/replacement of Church air handling unit
- Asphalt parking lot maintenance
- Power washing/cleaning of exterior stone
- Working with SFA on potential installation of volleyball equipment on the playground.
- Coordinating with donors on projects which may include Christmas lights at Rectory, upgrading sound system, carpet replacement, window replacement

Discussion:

1. Mics are being upgraded (bid is in, but it is not fixed yet); talks of it being fixed by December

- 2. Father McCabe said the readers can use the main pulpit if they need to (announcements, petitions, etc.); this will be communicated to Russ Bayer; it was asked if Bluetooth works with the new system; Ann will ask
- 3. The Committee is trying to identify some critical areas for the property, especially areas that are past their lifetime (heating and air, roof, parking lot, etc.); sending the information to Finance Council for decision making on how to afford these issues
